

Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section on the form for exhibitors to designate whether or not your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Any bitch that comes into season after the closing date may have their entry fee returned, less \$5 per run Administrative fee, by providing the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins. There will be no refund for injured dogs after the closing date.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Contacts are rubberized and weave pole spacing is 24" All classes will take place on a soccer turf surface. Ring sizes 85' x 120'.

COURSE WALK THROUGHTS AND WARM UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Rosettes/Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

Qualifying Score – Dark Green

First Place - Blue

Second Place - Red

Third Place - Yellow

Fourth Place - White

A decorated bar and ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain either a MACH or PACH title at this event. No Ribbons will be mailed.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at http://www.akc.org/rules/.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this agility trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging, however handlers arriving after the scheduled course walk through for their class has taken place are not guaranteed a chance to walk the course. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event. WAIT LIST: This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received prior to the closing date. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm CST, Monday, September 12, 2016 will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund, or the entry <u>destroyed</u>.

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

CATALOGS/RUNNING ORDERS: Running orders will be posted online after the wait list deadline has passed and posted onsite the day of the trial. and available on request to exhibitors. Full catalogs will be available by request the day of the trial for \$5.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The Agility Trial will be held at Players. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Pinch/prong collars are not allowed on the show site. Flexi leads must not be extended at all inside the building. Crate mats or other ground cover must be used underneath all crates. Unentered dogs are not allowed on the show site. Dogs must use the specified exercise area. Do not allow dogs to relieve themselves on the shrubbery or landscaping. Anyone caught not cleaning up after their dogs or exercising them in prohibited areas will be asked to leave, and may be subject to a Committee hearing. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made!

RV Parking is allowed on site, but spots will be assigned. Please contact Cathy Fleury, Trial Chairman, to make reservations.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
